

International Student Application Guidelines

- ① Those who are within 3 years (2 years for high school students) after completing their final education at the time of application.
- ② Prioritize for those applicants who graduated from university, graduate school, or major in technology.
- ③ Those who have Japanese language ability N5 (N5 equivalent) at the time of application.
- ④ Those who are studying Japanese enough to speak the reason for studying in Japan and have a clear purpose for studying in Japan.
- ⑤ A person who can be sure that he / she has received the financial support during the period of study.
- ⑥ Applicants with no application history.
